U.S. Paralympic Team athlete and U.S. National Champion **Thomas Walsh**, age 23, turned his grueling struggle with cancer in his early teens into the conquering of mountains, including some of the steepest slopes around the globe. Growing up in Vail, CO, his talent in winter sports was already putting him in the circle of elite athletes, but at age 14 when he was diagnosed with Ewings sarcoma, he had to focus his efforts to save his own life. The numerous after-effects of his treatments have left him physically challenged with nerve damage, a limping gait, and the life-long management of lymphedema. Mentally, however, the competitor remains, using his talent and discipline to continue skiing and inspire others.



Thomas proudly supports the **Lymphedema Treatment Act** (H.R.930/S.497), introduced by Reps. Dave Reichert (R-WA), Earl Blumenauer (D-OR), Leonard Lance (R-NJ), and Jan Schakowsky (D-IL);

as well as Sens. Chuck Grassley (R-IA) and Maria Cantwell (D- WA). His first-hand experience with lymphedema has been a challenge – more so than many of the other after-effects of the cancer treatment. Managing the swelling and staying active are essential to a healthy existence. Compression garments are key to maintaining a healthy life. The more he has learned about other cancer survivors with these same challenges, and others who were born with lymphedema, the more he is driven to speak out.
