Dear Colleague:

In recognition that today, March 6, is World Lymphedema Day, we invite you to join the Lymphedema Treatment Act as an original cosponsor. Last Congress, **385 members** of the House of Representatives cosponsored this bipartisan and bicameral legislation and we welcome your support again. The bill text is the same from <u>last Congress</u>, with the exception of the effective date. A complete one-pager is below.

- The Lymphedema Treatment Act (LTA) would require Medicare Part B to cover physician-prescribed compression therapy items that are used to treat lymphedema.
- The legislation defines these items to include multi-layer compression bandaging systems; custom or standard fit
 gradient compression garments; non-elastic and low-elastic compression garments and compression wraps and
 directional flow pads; and any other compression items determined by the Secretary of Health and Human
 Services to be effective in treating lymphedema.
- Numerous studies on compression therapy suggest this legislation has the potential to lower total health care
 costs associated with lymphedema by decreasing the incidence of lymphedema-related complications,
 comorbidities, and disabilities.
