Lymphedema is a chronic disease that results in a build up of lymph fluid (swelling) that occurs when the lymphatic system is either faulty or damaged. There is no cure, but it can be effectively treated.

Our group successfully led the effort to pass the Lymphedema Treatment Act, a federal bill to improve insurance coverage for compression supplies. Starting on 1/1/2024, Medicare will be required to cover lymphedema compression supplies, and this will also set a precedent for other insurance policies.
